The Mobile Health Outreach Bus provides healthcare and outreach services to people within Oxford County.

Why is the bus needed?

Many people who struggle with housing and transportation have difficulty accessing services. The bus provides an opportunity to access healthcare and outreach by bringing the services to them. It's there to support people right in the community.

What services are provided?

The bus has a nurse practitioner, outreach worker, and some community partners on board to provide:

- Care for health concerns
- Wound care
- Access to medical referrals
- Support with form completion
- Community resources/referrals
- Harm reduction supplies
- Personal hygiene supplies
- Emotional support





The Mobile Health Outreach Bus meets people right in the community, to support their healthcare needs.

Who can access bus services?

The bus can be accessed by anyone in Oxford County who may be vulnerable, at risk, or in need of healthcare or outreach.

Where does the bus stop?

The bus can be found at set weekly locations throughout Oxford County; however, these are subject to change.
